The Franklin Township Trustees are pleased to continue the expanded **Vacuum Leaf Collection Service** for fall 2023. Leaves should NOT be bagged for collection. Residents should rake leaves to the curbside and a special Leaf Vacuum crew will visit each neighborhood **ONCE** between October 30 and November 10, and then will make a second and <u>FINAL</u> pass between November 13 and November 24. Please see the attached schedule so you know which week your street will be collected. There will be NO LEAF COLLECTIONS in December as the leaves are wet with snow by then. You will need to make other arrangements for your leaves after your final November pick up.

Please rake your leaves to the roadside by the <u>SUNDAY</u> before your collection. Please make sure that your leaf piles are neat and accessible from the road. Parked cars, deep ditches and hedges kept us from reaching some piles last year. Also keep sticks, brush, branches, rocks, wood and dirt out of your leaves. Please keep brush and branches to be chipped separate from leaves.

Note: The week of October 2-6 will be the last week for chipping!

JUST A REMINDER:

Please place your loose piles of leaves (leaves only, please) at least 3 feet off the curb <u>no later than the SUNDAY before your scheduled pick up week</u> to ensure collection. Please do not place piles of leaves on bike/hike paths. Leaves will not be collected when placed in areas that cannot be reached by the leaf vacuum system or are deemed unsafe.

DID YOU KNOW?

You can mulch your leaves into your lawn for a healthier yard that will have increased soil fertility and reduced weed germination.
